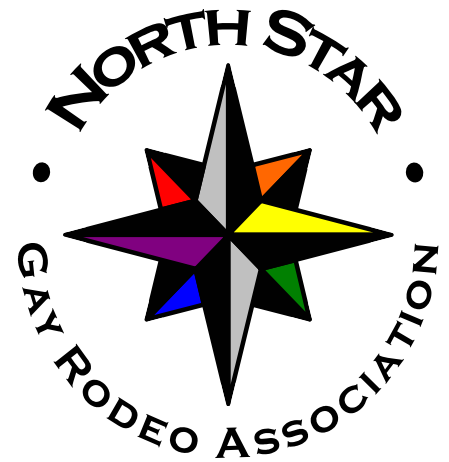

IGRA BOARD MEETING NOTES FROM PHOENIX**JACK ROACH**

- * IGRA group insurance for ACC \$1 million /AG \$2 million divided by 27 associations (\$322.57) + (\$322.57) for the 19 associations with rodeos this year brings NSGRA's premium to \$645.14
- * Liquor Liability is available for the lucky associations that get the concessions of their alcohol, like we do, for an additional \$625-650 through the same company. Contact Tommy Channel for the information.
- *IGRA is trying to increase the numbers of Certified Chute Coordinators on the circuit, so the same few people don't have to do them all. And if there are more of them the associations don't have to fly people in from so far away. Please consider becoming an IGRA Certified Rodeo Chute Coordinator or other Official and attend the IGRA University in February
- * IGRA University is looking for sponsors for breaks: Cookie & Soda breaks \$100/ Coffee Break \$200 / Sponsor a class \$500 / Endow a University Class series \$1000. Please contact Chancellor Brian Rogers at University@IGRA.com They also have parties planned for Friday, Saturday & Oscar-Sunday night, so if you go don't plan on leaving till Monday morning!
- * Marketing: The marketing committee is looking at new ways to market IGRA/Gay Rodeo to the public. There is a new glossy "Gay Sport's Magazine" offering IGRA full page adds that will be running each month. Kathy Griffin "The D List" will be filming a segment at the "Big-D Rodeo" in Dallas in March. "Giddy-Yap on the Rodeo" is supposed to be available now on iTunes.

- * IGRA Finals Rodeo 2008 ALSO in Denver. No one else put in a bid to help host 2008 Finals, so it was awarded to CGRA even though it is planned for a much earlier weekend in October 10-12th which will need to rearrange the final 3 rodeos of the rodeo year in 2008. All 3 have agreed to move them.
- * Louisiana State Gay Rodeo Association (LSGRA) was seated as an IGRA Rodeo Association. They are now 60 members strong & climbing. Their whole board was present for the AGRA weekend, and they are working on a proposal for the 2008 IGRA Convention
- * IGRA Convention & Dance Competition 2007 in Kansas City: Hotel Room Reservations are working so start booking your rooms.
